Hello to our Friends and Family,


In 1970 a 10-year-old strawberry blond white girl moved to Willingboro, NJ. Having spent the fist eight years of her life in Texas and the last two in a small town in Michigan, she had lived a fairly sheltered life. On her fist day joining her new fourth grade class the teacher sat her next to Donna and asked Donna to show her the ropes. It just happened that Donna had a different color of skin than this young white girl. The young girl and Donna became friends. They would meet at the crosswalk in the mornings and walk to school together. One morning the subject of race came up. During the 1960's and early 1970's, the word "colored" was often used to describe people with black skin. The young white girl asked her friend, "how should I describe you?" Donna's very proud response was, "I am black!" The friend asked, "So I should say you are black, not colored." Donna's response was, "I'm not colored. I have never gotten why black people are called colored. You have red hair, blue eyes, brown freckles and you blush pink when you are embarrassed. You are colored, not me."

Makes you think.... Some people truly are colorblind. They can't tell the difference between blue and green. However, for most of us color is a fact of life. We use color as a descriptor, "Suzy is white, she wore a blue dress today and had her blond hair up in a ponytail for church." "Janie is African American (black) and is wearing a pretty pink suit today. That's her over there talking to Jim."

God made us all different colors. In many ways we are his living, walking, talking rainbow. None of us can honestly say we don't see color when we look at someone. However, God did not make our skin colors a definition. Jesus said, "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." (Mark 12:31) That means all neighbors. Jesus also told his disciples "you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, in all of Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." (Acts 1:8) He sent his disciples (and us) out to minister to and love all the people of the earth equally. Although the disciples had their own prejudices, Jesus' commandment forced them to give up those preconceived definitions and see everyone as a brother and sister in Christ.

As you walk through your day, allow the color of the skin in the people you meet to be a descriptor, not a definition. Love all of them as you love yourself. See Christ in each of them.

CORONAVIRUS DISEASE 2019 (COVID 19)

As Pinellas County extends its state of emergency*, residents are asked to be careful and vigilant. The medical director at Pinellas County recommends wearing face masks and continue to wash your hands to protect yourself from Covid 19.

Seek medical attention if you feel your illness is worsening. If you have difficulty breathing or a fever. Also you should be tested if you are in close contact with someone with Covid 19 or are a resident in a community where there is an ongoing spread of Covid 19. Call your health care provider and tell them your symptoms and your exposure, they will help you decide whether you need to be tested. Also there is drive through testing available to everyone with or without symptoms.

To find out your test results contact your provider or facility that ordered or collected the test. It may take a lab 24 hours to run your test. But you might not get your results for several days.

*Pinellas County Commissioners voted unanimously June 5, to extend state of emergency through June 19. County Administrator said local state of emergency was needed to continue to be able to take measures to respond to and mitigate effects of COVID-19, to apply for FEMA reimbursements and purchase necessary supplies such as personal protective equipment.

Oakhurst UMC Apportionment Funding Progress for 2020

Fanny Crosby wrote some fantastic lyrics for hymns and we need to celebrate at Oakhurst the great things that God has done through His people. One of those things is the 2020 apportionment funding progress.

We are on track to reach our apportionment goal of being 100% paid by December 31st and we need that positive progress to continue with your financial giving.

As of the end of May, the total OUMC apportionment funding paid to the Florida conference of the UMC = \$30,259.00. That amount is 49.95% of the total of \$60,580 due for 2020. We are basically one month ahead in payments!

Five of the (13) apportionment category funds are paid in full.

There were (32) membership pledges made to apportionment funds during the fall Estimate of Giving campaign for a total of \$20,631.00 pledged! That amount is an increase of \$12,161.00 over 2019. Praise God!

I appreciate the commitment in 2020 of the Oakhurst church family to support our funding of connectional support for the global, conference, and local missions and ministries of the United Methodist Church.

God bless your gifts, and may God bless the giver! AMEN.


