

Hello to our Friends and Family,

1 Corinthians 8:1 says "Knowledge puffs up, but love builds up." How many of you have that friend that seems to know everything? That person who always corrects you and knows they are **always** right? 1 Corinthians 8 continues with "² Anyone who claims to know something does not yet have the necessary knowledge; ³ but anyone who loves God is known by him."

There is a difference between a "know-it-all" and a true genius. A "know-it-all" just thinks they know everything, a true genius probably does know everything in their field of study (and probably a few other areas, too). But more important than facts and figures is living your life to be known by God. Know-it-all or genius, knowledge is nice, but loving God and being known by him is a blessing surpassing knowledge.

As the verse above says, if you love God, He will know you. Isn't that a comfort, all you have to do is love God and He will know you. He will know your heart down to the depths of your soul.

Now those verses are taken a little out of context if you read the whole chapter. The whole chapter is talking about the trials of Christians trying to make sure they are not eating meat sacrificed to idols. Not a problem we have today.

However, that does not diminish the truth of the statement that "love builds up." God's love and knowledge of you supports you and helps you grow each and every day. He is not there to tear you down or break you apart. He knows you and supports you. "When I thought, 'My foot is slipping,' your steadfast love, O Lord, held me up." (Psalm 94:18)




Spotlight
