

### **News from Cuba**

This is the first of several little articles about our Cuba Mission. A few on our mission team are in frequent communication (through the Internet) with Pastor Eglis at our sister church. We will share praises and the needs we learn about.

"There is a shortage of 'everything' in Cuba," announced a recent headline. The article continued to describe the far-reaching scarcity of food, fuel, medicines, hygiene items, and raw materials. La Pastora Marlys, from our sister church in Colon, Cuba describes how she and other parishioners wait in a queue for hours at the grocery only to be turned away as no deliveries are made - not just one day but almost all days now. To obtain goods, people turn to the 'black market' and are forced to pay high prices - if they are lucky enough to find good available to buy.

Among the faithful in Cuba, there is no shortage of resilience and kindness. Church congregations share what they have with each other - bringing meals to those with COVID (only 5% of Cubans have been vaccinated) and sharing all they have with each other. This is a quote from one of the Cuban pastors "These are difficult times with many shortages, diseases, needs and much pain. But God has allowed us to live this in this extraordinary brotherhood and it gloriously fills our hearts to see how the brothers & sisters share with each other."

For about 8 years, Oakhurst UMC has provided mission outreach to our sister church La First Methodista Church in Colon. What you may not know, is that Pastor Eglis is also responsible for 20 'missionary' churches throughout rural Matanzas Province. So, when you give to the Cuban Mission Ministry, you are helping provide for the basic needs of a multitude.

Last Sunday, Pastor Nathan asked the question "Where is God working in the world and how can we join in?" God is working in Cuba through the United Methodist Church. Please consider making a monetary donation to our Cuba mission. Your dollars can help us purchase and send needed supplies through Cuba Pack and provide cash to our sister church, for their work. Thank you. Gracias.
