



Greetings and Blessings to our Congregation! Our apportionment funding actual income continues to exceed the projected income amount as of the end of July. Praise God!

We are still on track to pay 13 of 13 apportionment funds at 100% for fiscal year 2021!

Keep spreading this good news! Pledging for 2022 is only 3 months away. We are a connectional church joined with every other UMC in supporting the missions and ministries of the UMC around our District, Conference and the world!

2021 Oakhurst UMC Apportionment Payment Goals... (100% = \$58,339.00)

July **58.34**% \$ 34,032. **65.79**% \$ 4,613.00 \$ 38,377.39

Remaining amount to be Paid for 2021 = \$ 19,961.61

TIPS FOR A GOOD NIGHT'S SLEEP

PRACTICE HEALTHY HABITS DURING THE DAY:

- --Go to bed and wake up at the same time each day.
- -- Try to get at least 30 minutes of sunlight.
- -- Exercise regularly, but not within 2-3 hours before bedtime.
- -- Don't take naps after 3 pm.
- -- Avoid caffeine and nicotine.
- -- Avoid alcoholic drinks before bed.
- -- Avoid large meals and drinks late at night.
- --Avoid medicines that delay or disrupt your sleep, if possible.

CREATE A GOOD SLEEPING ENVIRONMENT:

- -- Have a comfortable mattress and pillow.
- --Keep the room temperature cool.
- -- Avoid distractions such as noises, bright lights, clocks, TVs, and computers.

TAKE TIME TO RELAX BEFORE GOING TO BED:

- -- Read a book or listen to music, and turn off the TV and electronic devices.
- -- Take a hot bath, which will adjust your body temperature and help you relax.

NOTE: If you are awake for more than 20 minutes, get up and do something relaxing. If you continue to have trouble sleeping, talk with your doctor.

Nuts and Bolts of Getting Provisions to Cuba

The last Cuba article described some of the challenges of getting provisions to Cuba. This article will explain how we are currently meeting the challenge.

Tampa Bay area Methodists United in Prayer (MUIP) is a non-profit ministry that connects US churches to UMC churches in Cuba. Oakhurst participates in this cooperative. MUIP helps us look for reliable ways to send things to Cuba in the most efficient time frame. Until recently, the MUIP recommended using CubaPack Envois out of Hialeah, FL to send U.S. dollars. There is a 35% fee (pre-COVID the fee was 10%) to send American money and there are limits on the amount that can be sent based on the total volume of money CubaPack is sending for clients. Just in the last month, MUIP can accept funds from individual churches (earmarked for their sister churches) and send (in volume) to a contact in Canada. The Canadian dollars are changed to US currency and sent to the individual sister churches in Cuba. This process can take 6-8 weeks, but the transaction fee is only 5%. This is how we are sending money now.

We can have medicines to Cuba directly through MUIP. Shipping other supplies - like food, hygiene items, hardware, etc. is tricker and quite expensive. A pound of ground pork, for example, is \$8.00. Provisions are shipped to Cuba from another country, such as Venezuela. supermarket23.com is a possibility. The website is in Spanish. Products available are limited depending on where you are sending too, and the delivery takes at least two weeks.

All this is why sending US dollars, rather than goods, is preferable. US currency can be used in bartering in the "underground market." Pastor can get more goods for the money that way and help more people in need.
