#### General Church Apportionments - The Funds We Support:

- World Service Fund This fund is the first benevolent responsibility of the church. It underwrites Christian missions around the world and supports the core ministries and proclamations of our denomination.
- General Administration Fund Provides funds for the costs of the General Conference held every 4 years; Provides funds for the maintenance of historic UM shrines and landmarks; compiles and distributes denominational statistics and records.
- 3. Episcopal Fund Supports all worldwide Bishop's Salaries and Benefits and their Episcopal Office and Residence, including our Bishop Ken Carter of the Florida Conference.
- 4. Interdenominational Cooperation Fund Supports the General Church ecumenical ministries, in mission with other Christian denominations, as an advocate for peace and justice in the world.
- 5. Ministerial Education Fund Funds will be made available to all certified candidates who are attending Seminary. 75% of monies received goes to the General Church for seminary students and 25% of monies received remains in the Florida Conference for student aid and continuing education support.
- Black College Fund There are (11) historically Black United Methodist-related colleges and a medical college, including Bethune-Cookman College in Daytona Beach, FL., which receive funds to support their operational expenses and capital improvement needs.
- Africa University Fund In Zimbabwe, Africa for the last 25 years, with over 7,000+ graduates. The university's
  mission is "to provide higher education of high quality, to nurture students in Christian values, and to help the nations
  of Africa achieve their educational and professional goals".
- 8. Jurisdictional Administration Fund Funds are needed for the Administrative Council and the programs that they support in places such as the Lay Ministry Training Center and the UMVolunteers in Mission. Funds are also used to support delegates to the 4-day SEJ Conference held every 4 years to elect new Bishops.

### The Categories of the Florida Conference Funds:

- 9. Clergy Support This fund pays the salaries, benefits and business expenses of the (9) district Superintendents in the Florida Conference and their Conference Cabinet expenses.
- 10. Conference Benevolences This apportionment pays for all campus ministers' salaries and operating expenses at the Florida college Wesley Foundations and any campus ministry facility costs.
- 11. Conference Services and Administration Fund This apportionment funds the cost of holding a Florida Annual Conference session each year and pays the operating expenses of the conference center in Lakeland.
- **12.** Equitable Compensation/Mission Support This fund exists to assist churches and missions who need financial support on a short-term basis.

#### **Gulf Central District Work Fund:**

13. This apportionment provides funding for the operations and missions of our Gulf Central District.

Current OUMC paid status for 2021 = **75.82%**, as of September 30th. Please **mark your pledge** to commit to being a connectional United Methodist Church **on the 2022 Stewardship Campaign Estimate of Giving Card.** 

We expect to pay 100% of apportionment funding every year! God bless the connectional ministry and missions of the UMC.
