

What is Alpha?

Alpha is a series of sessions exploring the basics of the Christian faith. Typically run over eleven weeks, each session looks at a different question that people can have about faith and is designed to create conversation. It's just an open, informal and honest space to explore and discuss life's big questions together. And it's free.

No two Alphas look the same, but generally, they have three key things in common: food, a talk, and good conversation:

- Food: Food has a way of bringing people together. It's no different at Alpha. Most sessions start with food because it's a great way to build community and get to know each other.
  - 2. Talk: The talks are videos designed to engage guests and inspire conversation.
