But there is no relaxing where our babies are concerned and our volunteers are always there and willing to help wherever they can. We also continue to need your help. Our diapers run us about \$1000 per month. The Dwellings on Seminole Blvd just ran an outside marketplace in front of their store on our behalf requesting people bring wipes for a chance to win a basket full of goodies from their store, and boy did they bring wipes! Two trunk loads were brought back to the church. We give these out with the diapers. Thanks to all who contributed.

Oakhurst UMC Missions 2021 Summary

Annual Budget from church: \$7400

Actual spending: budget+ designated gifts: \$60,895

Baby Basics: (\$10,746) Monthly diapers for up to 40 babies from low income employed families.

Kenya: (\$10,242) Building of a special needs school. (\$5000) from church budget to support the needs of Deb Ralph.

Food Pantry: (\$6,775) funds given to local food pantries. Oakhurst sends between 800 and 2500 pounds of food to pantries from each monthly food drive.

Shoe Fund: (\$5,574) Bought shoes for local children at Christmas and through "Clothes to Kids".

Street Ministry: (\$5,269) Food for 90-200 hot meals served 3-4 times each month at St Vincent DePaul. Food costs are kept low due to donations by many of the cooks.

Cuban Sister Church: (\$2890) Supported our sister church in Cuba. Food and supplies are used for needy people in the church and funded a Christmas Eve dinner for 400 church members.

Graduation fund: (\$2,325) Paid for cap and gown and diploma cover for graduates to participate in the ceremony.

Blanket Sunday: (\$1544) Purchased blankets through Church World Service for disaster relief.

United Methodist Children's Home: (\$1316) Supported the United Methodist Children's Home.

Pack-A-Sack: (\$1,378) Provided week-end food for 50 children at Walsingham Elementary. Costs are low due to food from the food drive and bulk milk purchases.

Backpacks and school supplies: (\$1490) 140 backpacks given to school children with supplies for teachers and children. Forty backpacks were distributed to homeless veterans.

Angel tree: Gifts for 50 children at Walsingham Elementary or Lift Academy. Each child received gifts, a shoe certificate and each family received a gift card to Publix.

The Food Pantry Box and the "Blue Box" for collecting clothing, blankets, towels, and hygiene items is outside the Fellowship Hall. Funds can be donated on-line or in the offering and designated for any Mission outreach.

Thank you to all who have designated gifts to Oakhurst UMC mission's programs.
