

I am very pleased to announce that the Oakhurst UMC Apportionment funding was paid in full in 2022 at 100% for the 3rd year in a row! (\$52,961.00):

\$28,152.93 was paid from the Operating Budget (10 months at \$2800 and one final payment of \$152.93).

\$940.00 was raised through two Suncoast Singers concerts.

\$1,915 was raised by the Shrove Tuesday Pancake Supper.

\$21,953.07 was donated from membership contributions. (\$3,393.07 over the pledged amount of \$18,560.00!)

It is very important that we continue to emphasize in 2023 the importance of paying our apportioned amount to the Florida Conference as a connectional church!

God Bless the UMC missions and ministries that are supported by connectional churches!

Our 2023 amount of apportionment has been reduced by \$4,780.00 to \$48,181.00.

Lower your 2023 Federal Income Taxes

Waiting for word from your financial institution concerning your Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) for 2023? This is the amount you MUST withdraw in 2023 from your IRA or qualified retirement account, like a 401k. If you are, did you know that if you have the financial institution send your RMD directly to Oakhurst, you can most likely deduct that amount directly from your taxable income, reducing your taxable income?

Having money sent directly from your IRA or other qualified retirement plan is referred to as a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD). If you are interested in making a QCD, you should contact your financial advisor or tax professional to see if a QCD might be a good tax savings strategy for you and to find out what procedures your IRA custodian has in place for making a QCD.


