Active Assailant Congregational Safety Information—A good read that needs repeating!

An Active Assailant Congregational Safety Training Event was held in the Oakhurst UMC sanctuary on Thursday, 7/28/22 at 10:30 am, coordinated by Marvin Strickland and Senior Pastor Nathan. Several other church representatives in our Gulf Central and Seminole community were in attendance. There were (41) attendees from OUMC, (7) from Beaming Hope Church in Largo, (16) from our neighbor First Christian Church on Park Blvd., and (1) person each from Bridgepoint Church and Tampa Korean UMC.

The guest speaker/trainer was Armando Feiho, a Deputy Sheriff in the Pinellas County Sheriff's Office. He presented an enlightening slide and video presentation that trained us in the three options for defense if we have an active assailant on our church campus.

<u>RUN!!!</u> Know the nearest exit opportunities and run away; get outside quickly.

HIDE!!! Look for a place to hide where you are located or barricade the doors to your room. Be quiet!

<u>FIGHT!!!</u> Be the person that controls or eliminates the threat, especially if you are near the threat.

Pulling a fire alarm is not recommended. Dialing 911 is recommended!

It is our prayer that we will never have to respond to this situation. Many thanks to the Pinellas County Sheriff's Office for having this training event.

In addition, on Sunday mornings, as the Sanctuary Traditional worship service has started, the ushers are directed to lock the remaining exterior door that is open (from the rear parking lot) from the Foundry through to the Fellowship Hall. All other entrance doors are locked except for the front sanctuary entrances. The ushers are monitoring all guests who enter to the worship service.
